



Most recent gang position, rank, or affiliation among adults (N = 610)






Most recent gang position, rank, or affiliation among juveniles (N = 101)



Member commitment & dedication to gang

Percent that agree with the following statements:

- 55% (n=22) My gang has very little to do with how I feel about myself
- 51% (n=21) My gang is an important reflection of who I am
- 43% (n=17) Belonging to my gang is an important part of me
- 70% (n=28) My gang has almost nothing to do with what kind of person I am
- 54% (n=22)My gang is a big part of my life
- 83% (n=33)

 The members of my gang are cooperative with each other

Member commitment & dedication to gang, Cont.

Percent that agree with the following statements:

- 85% (n=34)
 The members of my gang know that they can depend on each other
- 95% (n=38) The members of my gang stand up for each other
- 48% (n=19) Being in a gang makes a person feel important
- Gang members provide a good deal of support for on another
- Being a member of a gang makes a person feel like he is a useful person to have around
- 33% (n=13) Being a member of the gang makes me a person who feels like he really belongs somewhere

Member commitment & dedication to gang, Cont.

Percent that agree with the following statements:

- 56% (n=22)
 Being a member of a gang is really enjoyable
- 53% (n=20) Being in a gang is a good way to make money
- 74% (n=29) A gang member expects to remain in the gang for many years
- 43% (n=17) A gang member would leave the gang if something better came along
- 64% (n=25) There is no future belonging to a gang
