Meta-analysis is a powerful method for researchers to critically evaluate existing research findings as well as generate theories/directions for future research and practice. The importance of meta-analysis spans diverse fields, including social sciences, medicine, education, and beyond. This workshop is designed to provide participants with the foundational knowledge and practical skills to conduct rigorous reviews and meta-analyses. Specifically, participants will learn steps of conducting a meta-analysis, from defining research questions to data extraction, effect size calculation, heterogeneity/moderation analysis, and publication bias assessment. Participants will engage in hands-on exercises of doing a meta-analysis using software such as STATA and R. The workshop will also demonstrate how to write up a compelling meta-analysis manuscript with clarity, rigor, and adherence to reporting guidelines such as PRISMA.
